Guidelines:

Grade Prep (10 minutes per day)

Reading every night which may include independent reading, being read to or a shared reading with and by parents/guardians (*recorded in reading diary*).
Practise maths skills.

Grade One and Two (15 minutes per day)

Reading every night which may include independent reading, being read to or a shared reading with and by parents/guardians (recorded in reading diary).
Practise maths skills.

Grade Three and Four (equivalent to 20 minutes per day)

Daily reading (recorded in diaries and signed by parents).
Practise maths skills

Grade Five and Six (equivalent to 30 minutes per day - to a maximum of 120 minutes per week)

Daily reading (recorded in diaries and signed by parents).
Practise maths skills

Additional tasks may be set by the teacher where appropriate. If for any reason your child is unable to complete homework, please let the classroom teacher know.

Role of Teacher:

Explain homework structure and expectations.
Set and clarify homework tasks.
Monitor homework and provide appropriate feedback.
Differentiate homework for students where necessary.

Role of Students:

Take home any materials necessary to complete homework.
Take responsibility for completing their homework and managing their time (3-6).
Seek clarification from the teacher where necessary.

Role of Parents/Guardian:

Sign child's reading diary.
Assist in providing an environment and routine that supports your child to complete homework tasks.
